The **Rule of Law** provided the foundations for the **recognition** of Henry and Susannah Kable's **human rights** by **recognising and enforcing** their property rights.



4. Economic Growth occurred in the colony as a result of **increased demand and investment, driven by protected individual and collective rights.**



3. Investment increased in the colony in response to secure property rights, **creating consumption and more demand** for labour, and **more incomes** for other people in the colony.



1. After arriving with the First Fleet to find their property missing, **convicts Henry and Susannah** sought the **protection of the law to recover** their missing parcel.

2. They were **treated as equals** with the ship's captain and **their right to property was recognised.** Knowing their rights were secure, **they provided labour and started a business to gain income and property.**
